#### **PART II: REVIEW PROCESS**

Below are the steps you are required to take for review of your Small Wireless Facility Application. Note that steps taken by staff, such as routing of your application to other departments, are not shown here.

The following steps are required of you, the applicant:

- A pre-application meeting with staff is encouraged to determine what application you will need to submit based on the scope of work you will be doing.
  - All applications will be administrative
- Submit a complete and correct application (see checklist) and fees.
- Provide revised documents as required by staff.

The applicable review timeframe is 60 days for an application for collocation of Small Wireless Facilities using a preexisting structure and 90 days for review of an application for attachment of Small Wireless Facilities using a new structure. To toll the timeframe for incompleteness, the City must notify the applicant in writing within 10 days of the submission of the application, delineating all missing documents or information. Upon resubmission by the applicant, the 60-day or 90-day shot clock, as applicable, will be reset and restart. Following the supplemental submission, the City will notify the applicant within 10 days if the supplemental submission did not provide the information identified in the original notice of incompleteness. The timeframe is then tolled or may be tolled by mutual agreement of the City and applicant. The timeframe may be tolled in the same manner for subsequent submittals.

The City of Post Falls will provide you with clarification of its interpretation of statutes, ordinances, codes or policy statements as requested.

#### PART III: SUPPORTING MATERIALS AND INFORMATION

- □ Letter of Authorization from the Property Owner approving the facility on their property, or if the facility is in the right-of-way, an attestation that the applicant has authorization to install, maintain, and operate transmission/reception equipment in the right-of- way. Further permitting through the Public Works Division may be required.
- □ Site plan including, for example:
  - Drainage and traffic statements, stamped by a registered civil engineer, are required with a site plan.
- Photo simulations showing before and after renderings of the site and any structures, vegetation, or topography that will screen the proposed facility from multiple viewpoints.
  Selected viewpoints should be located approximately a half-mile, 1 mile, and 2 miles from the site with an accompanying map showing where each photo was taken.
- □ Elevation drawings
- □ If <u>not</u> a collocation on an existing vertical element, the following additional materials are also required:
  - o List of existing vertical elements within a 1-mile radius
  - o Narrative explaining why the applicant cannot collocate
  - Policy statement on mitigation of tower proliferation
  - Collocation policy
  - Signal coverage maps
  - Engineer's capacity report
  - o FAA and FCC compliance statement from an engineer
- □ Three hard copies and a USB drive containing pdf images of all documents
