DISCOUNT: Prior to May 27, a 10% discount will be offered on a per camper basis for full payment at the time of registration if the camper is signed up for 6 weeks or more. Please contact our office for a verified discount code. DOES NOT APPLY TO FIELD TRIP FEES OR APPAREL ITEMS.

PAYMENT PLAN: Payment plans are eligible for those registering for 5 or more weeks. Those desiring a payment plan must call to register prior to July 8. The first week's registration fee is due at the time of registration, then an automatic credit card payment will be charged on the Monday two weeks prior to the registered weeks. Payment plans must be current two weeks prior to the registered week. Failure to meet this requirement will result in removal from camp.
