Cemetery Spring Clean-Up

Spring clean-up at Evergreen Cemetery will begin Monday, June 12th. Cemetery staff will remove Memorial Day flowers and other non-conforming decorations not in standard flower containers. Seasonal decorations and temporary displays that may constitute a problem will be removed and discarded in accordance with the City's cemetery regulations. Please remember glass, ceramics, and other breakables are not permitted in the cemetery at any time.
